Humphries started brokering in 1998 with Jetsave Travel. 'I went back into retail store ownership for a few years but was back brokering by 2004. It started as a lifestyle choice as I had three young children, but as the business has grown and technology improved it is so much more than that now.'







Emirates is partnering with Auckland Tourism and Economic Development (ATEED) and Eat Drink Love Ponsonby to bring India's acclaimed and awarded chef Manish Mehrotra of Indian Accent restaurants to New Zealand this week.

Air Vanuatu (NF) is updating trade on its flights that are using a Nauru Airlines aircraft from Auckland to Vanuatu and vice versa.

With NF's increased frequency to AKL to six weekly from mid-June this year and three times a week to MEL, NF has leased one aircraft from Nauru Airlines to make this possible. The arrangement is expected to be in place until June 2020, at which time NF is expecting to receive its first A220-300.

Until then AKL and BNE services will

be operated on a Nauru Airlines aircraft. Provided on board will be meals, drinks and bar service. For entertainment, because of the aircraft B737-300, clients are advised to download movies on their own devices before their flight.

The captain and first officer are Nauru Airlines crew, however the cabin service is provided by NF crew.

Note, because there is less capacity and spaces in the overhead lockers on this aircraft, NF will be strict on 7kg carry-on weight limit.

Naumi's second in Queenstown



Naumi Hotels has acquired another hotel in Queenstown — Central Ridge Boutique Hotel. This comes on the back of its recent acquisition of The Dairy Private Hotel, also located in Queenstown.

Central Ridge Boutique Hotel is close to the town centre, and a 15-minute drive from Queenstown International Airport. To align the hotel with the Naumi brand, its guest rooms and facilities will undergo a phased renovation, scheduled to be completed in 2020. During this period, doors remain open and business is as usual as guests will not be impacted by the changes.

With Central Ridge Boutique Hotel, Naumi Hotels now owns and/or manages seven hotels in Singapore, New Zealand and Australia.

Tourism operator thl has named Shannon Corkill as Discover Waitomo's environmental manager.

The Discover Waitomo group operates several tourism experiences in the Waikato region, including the Waitomo Glowworm Cave, Ruakuri Cave, Aranui Cave, The Legendary Black Water Rafting Co. and Waitomo Homestead.

As the group's environmental manager, Corkill will oversee and lead a team that is responsible for monitoring and ensuring the sustainable management of the cave's fragile ecosystem as part of a broader environmental programme that Discover Waitomo undertakes. Efforts include monitoring of carbon dioxide (CO2), water level and cave temperature



and airflow, preserving the health of the cave environment and the glowworms that reside in the caves.

Hump Ridge on track to be next Great Walk

Southland's 61km Hump Ridge Track is set to be New Zealand's next Great Walk.

Minister of Conservation, Eugenie Sage says the track provides access to a spectacular southern coastline and forests, alpine tops and historic viaducts.

'This is a significant investment in Southland tourism and the Tuatapere community. Great Walk status can draw more visitors to this beautiful part of the country.

'Great Walks showcase some of the best parts of our country and are a great way to enable more people to enjoy and be inspired by nature to help protect it.'

Hump Ridge Track is one of three finalist walks (the other two being Te Paki Coastal Track and Queen Charlotte Track) identified through DOC's search for potential Great Walks, which began in 2017 with a call for public nominations.

DOC will continue its work in the far north to progress plans for what is currently Te Paki Coastal Track becoming a Great Walk.

The decision has been made not to progress with Queen Charlotte Track due to insurmountable challenges around surety of permanent public access across all sections of the track.

'Queen Charlotte is a fantastic and highly popular track already achieving great results for the region. DOC will continue to support the work of the landowners, commercial operators, Marlborough District Council, iwi and community that has made this track the success it is today,' says Sage.



Cool spot almost off the map

For agents with clients looking for an experience that's almost off the map, the new floating Arctic Bath Hotel and Spa can now be booked through Off The Map Travel. Reservations are open for the period February 2020 to February 2021.

The Arctic Bath Hotel and Spa, located in Lulea, Swedish Lapland, freezes into the Lule River in the winter and floats on top of the water in the summer.

The hotel is comprised of six detached floating 'cabins' and six additional cabins on land, plus the arctic bath, inspired by the timber floating era which recalls how felled trees were transported downriver for processing. Both the spa and the rooms float on or are frozen into water, depending on the season, ranging from 6.5 to 14 feet deep and are connected by wooden walkways.

Adventure World's expert in group and family travel, Angela Mount has recently returned from safari in Africa with her three children aged 8, 14, 15 and shares her top tips for agents in preparing clients for safari with their kids.

Travelling as a group of five people, private vehicles were included as part of the itineraries, and the flexibility that this brings is 'absolutely essential' according to Mount. 'Not every person on safari would want to stay and count spots on a sleeping cheetah like we did, plus we had the freedom to avoid the 5am wake ups to prepare for game drives. Although I would recommend that if clients are going to Africa for a longer holiday, do the safari bit first as they can use jetlag in their favour to make the most of 5.30am game drive starts.'

Mount and her family stayed at three different camps on their trip through South Africa, Botswana and Zimbabwe. There has been progress made on providing facilities to refill drink bottles with safe drinking water and Mount advises guests to remember to pack their own bottle. She still recommends however, to avoid tap water completely, even for teeth brushing.

Mount's other top tips for agents include advising clients to pack as light as possible (under 15kg per soft-sided bag for the charter flights – most camps include laundry as part of package costs) and to pack muted colours to wear – unlike her 15 year old son who learned the hard way by wearing a bright yellow jumper.



Tourism funding boost for Northland

Northland Inc has welcomed the Government decision to pump more than \$1.6m of tourism funding into the restoration, improvement and care of regional treasures.



Christening in Antarctica
