A panel of independent moderators to judge the finalists.
No presentations required.

Winners announced at NTIA25 Awards Dinner @ Cordis, Auckland

The judges' decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into, without exception.



QUESTIONS and CATEGORIES

- 4 written questions per category with a maximum of 3000 characters (average 500 words) per question.
- 1 or 2 qualifying questions per category require a simple figure, either a \$ or a %. (*\$ answers in NZD, excluding GST*).

GENERAL TERMS and CONDITIONS

- To enter any NTIA25 Awards category you must be a current TAANZ Member at the time the entry is lodged and when finalists are announced at the NTIA25 Awards evening.
- Entry can be nomination via a third person or via self-nominated.
- There is no entry fee. Expenses incurred completing a submission is at the expense of the applicant.
- The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into without exception.
- If requested by judges, clarification or validation on some answers may be asked, to complete the judging process.
- At the time of the Awards presentation, the entrants in any of the categories must be working for the Member under which they entered the awards.
- All entries become the property of TAANZ on submission. No entries or entry data will be returned. All entries should be saved by the entrant as their own personal record.



GENERAL TERMS and CONDITIONS (continued)

- Members to circulate the NTIA25 Awards entry form within their business as they deem appropriate.
- As % and/or \$ figures are required, the Member should verify this information prior to submission (*proof may be requested during the judging process*).
- Judges may reserve the right to re-categorise your entry.
- There is no limit on the number of submissions per Member, however each NTIA25 Award entry must be on a separate form.
- No alterations will be permitted to entries after 5.00pm 28 February 2025.
